



## **One South Euclid Announces Fiscal Sponsorship Program**

“Last year, we successfully piloted our fiscal sponsorship program twice” said OSE Governance Director Theron Cyrus. “We vetted the process and established the administrative and legal backing necessary for a program of this nature. The red tape’s removed and the heavy lifting is complete. Now we are ready to meet with applicants and see what we can do to help them get on their way.”
