

Property Tax Assistance

PROGRAM DETAILS

CHN's Property Tax Assistance Program is designed to prevent displacement and foreclosure of homeowners when that default is due to an inability to pay property taxes due to a pandemic-related hardship. Funded by the Ohio Housing Finance Agency (OHFA) via U.S. Department of the Treasury, these funds are made available through the American Rescue Plan of 2021. Funds are currently available through December 31, 2022.



HOW MUCH ASSISTANCE CAN I RECEIVE?

Cuyahoga County homeowners who qualify for the program can access a one-time grant of up to \$10,000 to pay for property taxes. Program funding is limited.

PROGRAM QUALIFICATION

Assistance is available for owner occupied households who have experienced a COVID-19 hardship after January 21, 2020. The property must serve as the owner's primary residence.

Applications are processed on a first come, first serve basis. Information on program guidelines, eligibility criteria, and required documentation is available through the program application page (link below).
