**SOUTH EUCLID FIRE DEPARTMENT** is excited to work in conjunction with the Community Partnership on Aging. Residents of South Euclid that are 60 and older are offered a wide variety of programs to access such as Community meals, social work, volunteer, CARE, Safe at Home, and transportation services. Residents are also eligible for Home Fire Safety Checks and Residential Lock Box Programs.



**Lunch Box-** Lunch Box is available twice per month. They are takeaway meals freshly prepared by our own chef and volunteers for just 5\$. **216-970-0347**

**Community Meals-** Daily Community Meals are served at 11:45 am and are available to anyone 60 years of age or older. They cost just a \$1.50 voluntary donation and are nutritionally balanced. Salads are now another healthy option! Reservations are required. **216-650-4029**

**Produce Plus-** In partnership with the Cleveland Foodbank, CPA offers a monthly food distribution. Produce is available for older adults 10:00 am on the third Thursday of each month at the South Euclid Community Center, 1370 Victory Drive, South Euclid, OH 44121. **216-291-3902**

**Hillcrest Meals on Wheels-** Hillcrest Meals on Wheels is a local non-profit, volunteer-driven organization, which offers home delivered hot meals to older adults in the area Monday-Friday. Our social workers can help you register. There is a cost associated with the meals and a deposit is required to begin the service. **440-442-2626 Extension 244**

**Programs-** CPA offers many programs such as line dancing, watercolor, movies, yoga, book club, woodworking, knitting, board games, and educational presentations. Programs are both in person and virtual. Our programs change regularly, so please check our schedules in the newsletter and online. All daily CPA programs are open to the public. **216-650-4029**

**Transportation-** Individual and group transportation is available through CPA-contracted Senior Transportation Connection (STC) Monday through Friday from 8:00 am-3:30 pm, for residents of CPA cities. Prior registration is required. Grant funding is available to accommodate those with lower income. Please allow at least five business days for registration. **440-442-2626 Extension 244**

**CARE (Communities Assisting Residential Elders)-** CARE is a membership-based service that offers coordination and completion of tasks in and around the home. Members receive 5 service bundles per year. Bundles include yard clean-ups, window cleaning, home organization and technology assistance. There is a cost associated with this program.

**(\$200 Annual Membership fee for those who are income eligible 216-970-0599 to register for CARE)**

**Social Work Services-** Supportive services provided by social workers can reduce future risks through early problem identification, and improve the quality of life through access to resources. A wide range of services are offered including assistance with information and referral, education, consultation and supportive counseling. **440-442-2626 Extension 244**

**Safe at Home-** Home owner assistance with minor home modifications, such as the installation of grab bars and railings, is provided through CPA in collaboration with the fire departments of CPA cities. Social workers can do an environmental safety assessment and provide durable medical equipment on loan (as available). **440-442-2626 Extension 244 for application**
